Schedule for Thursday's 9/11 memorial service

Thursday, September 11th 2008, 4:00 AM

8:40 a.m. - Service begins, with the [World Trade Center](#) flag brought to the stage as "The Star Spangled Banner" is performed by the [Young People's Chorus of New York](#).

8:46 a.m. - [Mayor Bloomberg](#) introduces moment of silence, marking the time of impact at the north tower. Bells then toll at houses of worship citywide.

8:47 a.m. - As 105 pairs of readers begin reciting the names of the 2,751 victims, family members descend the ramp into Ground Zero.

9:03 a.m. - Second moment of silence, marking time of impact at south tower. [Gov. Paterson](#) and New Jersey Gov. Corzine deliver readings.

9:59 a.m. - Third moment of silence, marking collapse of the south tower. Former mayor [Rudy Giuliani](#) delivers reading.

10:29 a.m. - Fourth moment of silence, marking collapse of the north tower. Former governor [George Pataki](#) and [Homeland Security Secretary Michael Chertoff](#) deliver readings.
